

The Ant and the Grasshopper

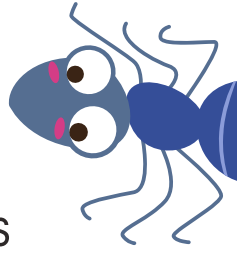

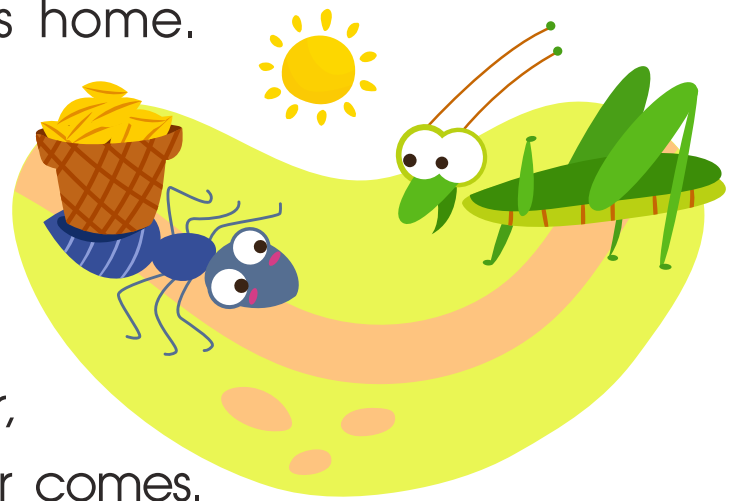


1. Read the story.
