


A Monkey Maze of Tens

The ten little monkeys are tired of jumping. Their heads hurt and they want to get back to bed. Draw a line through all the pictures that show **10** to help the monkeys get back to their bed.



The maze consists of ten paths, each containing a different set of objects:

- Path 1 (top left): A group of 10 monkeys. A green circle with the word "start" is next to them.
- Path 2 (top middle): A 2x5 grid of 10 blue dots.
- Path 3 (top right): A 3x3 grid of 9 different chocolate pieces.
- Path 4 (middle left): A 1x5 grid of 5 green dots.
- Path 5 (middle): A vertical stack of 10 orange blocks.
- Path 6 (middle right): A 2x5 grid of 10 orange dots.
- Path 7 (bottom left): A horizontal row of 3 purple cubes.
- Path 8 (bottom middle): A 5x2 grid of 10 green dots.
- Path 9 (bottom right): A group of 10 children.
- Path 10 (bottom): A horizontal row of 10 pink blocks.
- Path 11 (bottom right): A vertical column of 10 colorful butterflies.
