Telling Temperature

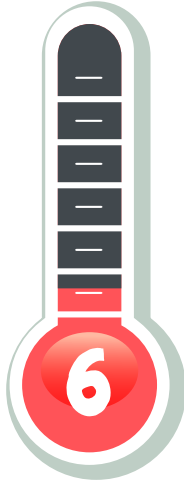
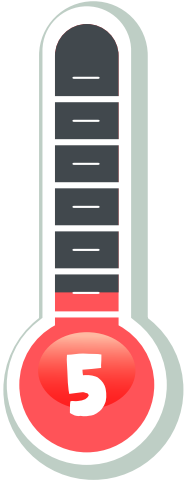

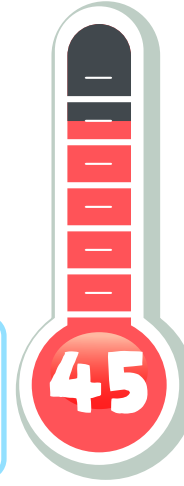
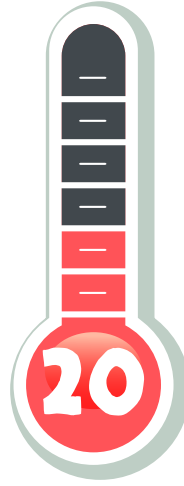
When you multiply by 5, the product will always end in a **0** or **5**. Multiply to find the product. Check the thermometer with the correct product.

$$5 \times 3 = 15$$

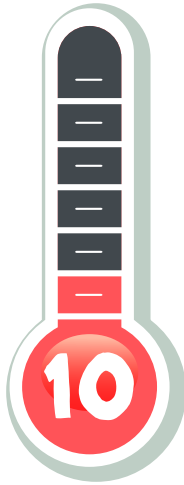
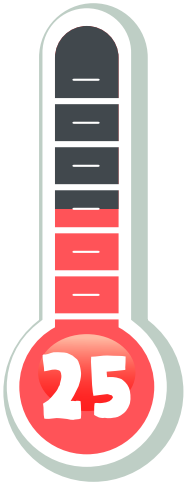
