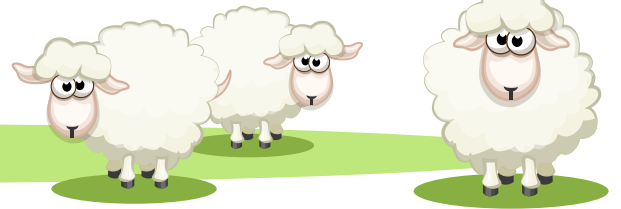
Read the fable and complete the sentences below by drawing a circle around the correct answer.
