
## En Passant: Tricky Pawn Capture

When a pawn moves two squares from its **INITIAL** position and passes a **SQUARE CONTROLLED BY AN ENEMY PAWN**, the enemy pawn can capture it. The pawn gets captured as if it had only moved ONE SQUARE. This move

is called "en passant" which means "in passing".
