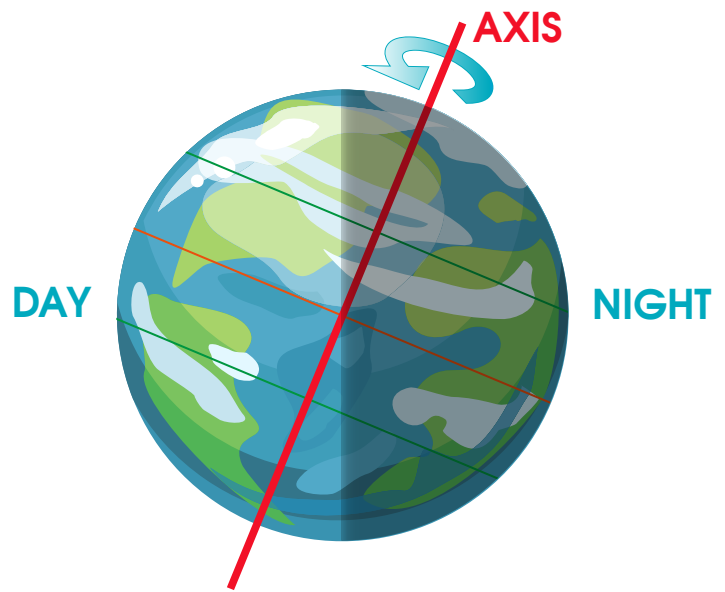


Our Solar System: Earth's Rotation
