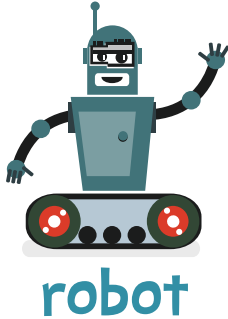


Learning Syllables
