

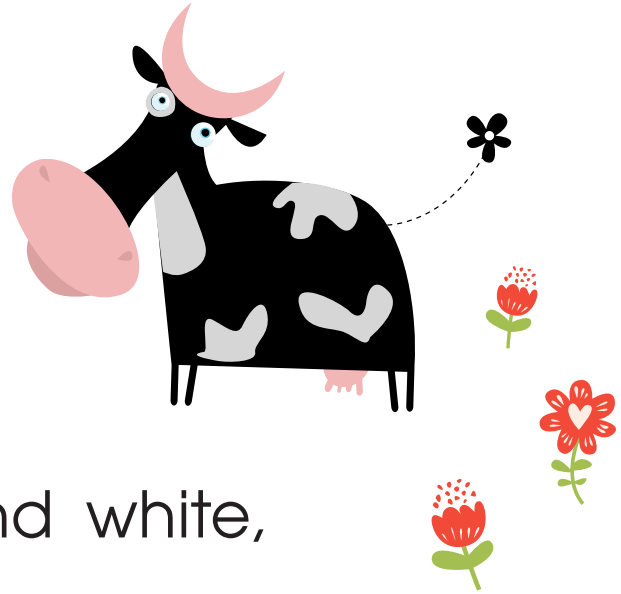
Rhyme in Poetry
