

# Multiplying in the Rainforest

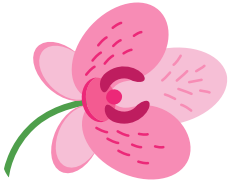
When you multiply by 10, the product will always end in a zero. It's just like counting by 10's!
