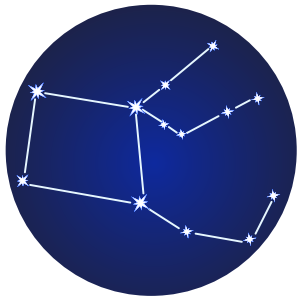


Constellations Word Search

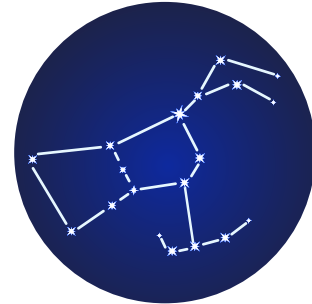
A constellation is a group of stars that looks like a figure. There are 88 constellations in the sky. In ancient times, these constellations worked as guidelines for travelers to find their way.

Its four bright stars form the Great Square.



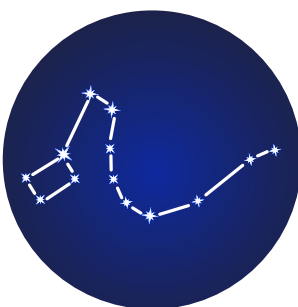
ORION

It contains one of the largest stars known, Betelgeuse.



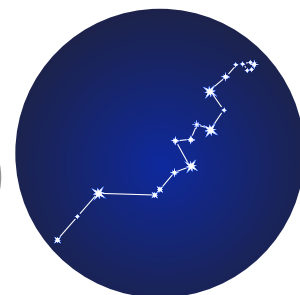
VIRGO

It's the second largest constellation.



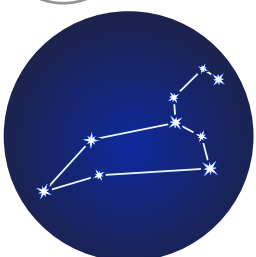
DRACO
