

# BUBBLE GRAMMAR: Possessive Nouns

## A **POSSESSIVE NOUN**

shows that a person or thing owns or has something.

You should add an **APOSTROPHE** and an **S** to a **SINGULAR NOUN**.

**FOR EXAMPLE:**  
the ladybug's spots.

You should add an **APOSTROPHE** to a **PLURAL NOUN** ending in s.

**FOR EXAMPLE:**  
the birds' nests.
