A POSSESSIVE NOUN

shows that a person or thing owns or has something.

You should add an APOSTROPHE and an S to a SINGULAR NOUN.

FOR EXAMPLE: the ladybug's spots.

You should add an APOSTROPHE to a **PLURAL NOUN** ending in s.

FOR EXAMPLE: the birds' nests.
