

Commas in Dates

You should add a comma to separate the day from the year. Use a comma after the year if it comes in the beginning or middle of a sentence.

For example: *My sister was born on June 24, 2009.*

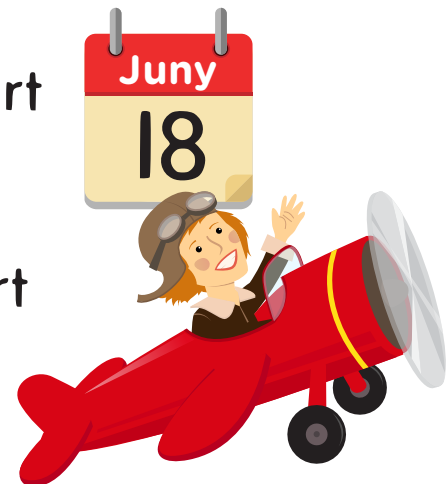
